## **Housing Crisis Leading to Share Homes and Co-Tenancies**

In the current market, there is huge crisis for housing. Macwell does our best to give everyone a fair and equal opportunity. We have noticed in recent times that there is a huge increase in tenants looking for share homes and co-tenancies due to prices rising.

The premier erupted in parliament when she was questioned about the reduction in her electorate, calling Mander "a disgrace".



The housing crisis is being felt right across Australia but in Queensland it's become so bad that some people are choosing to stay in prison rather than take their chances out on the street.

Amid that desperation, the Queensland premier has been caught out reducing public housing properties in her own working class electorate at a time when demand has never been higher.

A record 50,000 people are now waiting for government subsidised housing across Queensland and the state government-run Housing Service Centre in Inala is filled with stories of heartache.

Against this desperate backdrop of the need for more public housing in the electorate of Inala, local MP and Premier Annastacia Palaszczuk has overseen a decrease of bedrooms available.

An analysis of Queensland government social housing statistics shows that in the past four years, the number of bedrooms available in Inala has decreased by 102, the largest drop of any electorate in the state.

The Labor-held seats of Bundamba (64), Bancroft (57), Stafford (45) and Gaven (34) round out the top five with the highest reduction in social housing bedrooms from 2018 to 2021 inclusive.

Macwell understand that the current housing crisis is very overwhelming and stressful for many tenant and landlords.

Queensland is heading towards a severe housing crisis, with a projected shortage of 106,000 homes by 2027. This dire situation arises from high-interest rates, surging immigration, and community resistance to new developments.

### **Home Insurance**

#### Thinking of cancelling your landlord insurance policy? Read this first.

There's no denying that the cost of living is on the rise – groceries, petrol, utilities. The cost of managing your rental may also be increasing – interest rates rising, escalating prices for goods and services impacting routine maintenance and repairs, higher council rates and possibly even property manager fees going up.

#### "It's unnecessary"

Insurance can seem like an unnecessary expense when you don't need to make a claim. You might luck out and never have something go pear-shaped at your rental. Then again, you might not. Last year, EBM RentCover settled more than 6,400 claims with a value of more than \$39 million. That's a lot of landlords who weren't so lucky.

#### "The bond will cover it"

If you're thinking you don't need landlord insurance because you've got the bond money to cover rent arrears or damage, think again. A bond only covers four weeks' rent and if there's major damage to the property and/or unpaid rent, that bond is going to be drained and you're going to be left to foot the bill (and possibly chasing your tenants through the courts – a costly proposition).

NOTE: At EBM RentCover, the average amount that got paid out in a single claim in 2022 was \$7395.06 – this dollar amount is typically more than four-weeks rent in most properties.

#### "Insurance isn't worth it"

The value of insurance is subjective; it's personal to you. You may be happy to risk not having insurance, or you may value the safety and comfort of knowing you're covered financially if things go wrong at your rental. With the right landlord insurance (and depending on the policy you have), you can be protected against:

- · damage from severe weather events and natural disasters such as storm, hail, bushfire, flood, cyclone, lightning or earthquake
- · loss of rent
- · accidental, intentional and malicious damage
- · theft and attempted theft
- · house fire
- water damage
- fixed glass breakage
- impact
- public liability.

Without landlord insurance, you may find yourself paying for damage, losing income from non-payment of rent, losing your investment property (if you can't afford to repair/replace it) or even jeopardising your financial future if you are sued for negligence (public liability claims can stretch into the hundreds of thousands and millions of dollars).

- 1. Dish Detergent For blockages caused by built-up grease and oils deposits. The detergent should break down oils and fats as well as also act as a lubricant for other bits and pieces like food particles.
- 2. Blast It With Water The pressure can help to dislodge even the most stubborn blockages.
- 3. Vacuum Using a wet and dry vacuum can prove very effective, especially if what's blocking your drain is easily dislodged and light enough to get sucked up by a vacuum
- 4. The Zip Tie Method If you've got a few spare zip ties lying around connect a couple together to form a "drain snake". Next, cut small notches into one end so it forms a mini harpoon-like device. Lower this down the drain and try wiggling it around


